ONE-PAGER Project: (Name of Novel)

You will create a one-page visual of the novel (name of novel) on an 8 ½ x 11 piece of paper. Your page will be a visual representation of key elements and significant details related to the literary elements listed below.

Include the following elements either in picture or written form (or both):

- Write your name on the **BACK** of the white paper.
- On the front, begin by writing the full title of the novel in the middle of your page. Include the name of the author.
- You will include words and pictures that show details about the **setting, plot, and theme**. Use the rubric below as a guide. Words and drawings may be randomly placed on the page in no particular order. It is *not* necessary to label the literary elements or organize them in any way, but you may show connections if you choose.
- Include a word or phrase somewhere on your mind map that identifies a **theme**. It need not be *labeled* as a theme, but include at least one element that supports that theme.
- Use words, quotes, and/or drawings to represent the elements. Keep your drawings and words compact (i.e. do not try to fill your page quickly with large letters and drawings). The more color and information you can get on the page, the more impressive! However, make sure your letters are neatly written and large enough to be legible.
- To complete the page, add key quotes from the novel, additional pictures related to events, names of characters, or anything of significance in the novel.

IMPORTANT: BE PREPARED TO EXPLAIN HOW YOUR PROJECT MEETS THE CRITERIA ABOVE.
